BASKETBALL COURTS ARE SCARCE

Training venues with full size basketball courts that are available to hire are scarce and in great demand. Our club is fortunate that we have developed a great relationship with a number of local primary and secondary schools and a church in the local and neighbouring municipalities, giving our teams the use of their basketball courts for training.

RESPECT FOR FACILITIES AND SUPERVISION

To ensure our ongoing use of these facilities we need to ensure that we are respectful of these facilities and follow the school's rules. One of the codes of conduct that we have all agreed to comply with is to "always respect the use of facilities and equipment provided. Facilities and equipment cost money and will only function properly if kept in good order. Ensure that you do not abuse anything provided for use." Another code of conduct that relates to both parents and spectators is to "keep children in your care under control."

SUPERVISION OF SIBLINGS/OTHER CHILDREN

If other children are brought to training or games, they must be supervised at all times by their parent or a responsible adult while on the school premises. Children must not be allowed to run around, run onto the court, play in the toilets, climb any of the equipment, play outside or wander around the venues. They always need to remain close by and within your control.

PARENTS WILL BE LIABLE IF A SIBLING IS INJURED OR CAUSES MATERIAL DAMAGE TO THE SCHOOL.

CHILDREN WHO ARE NOT PROPERLY SUPERVISED WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE BY THE COLLEGE STAFF OR ABERFELDIE JETS COACH. IF THIS OCCURS, YOU RUN THE RISK OF HAVING YOUR CHILD DEREGISTERED FROM OUR PROGRAMS AND YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A REFUND.

RULES FOR USING OUR TRAINING FACILITIES

- Players are not to be dropped off prior to their scheduled training time;
- Players are not to be left unsupervised (if the coach has not arrived then players are not to be left);
- No one is to be inside the stadium unless the coach and/or team manager is present;
- If other children are brought to training or games, they must be supervised at all times by their parent or a responsible adult (not the Coach) while on the premises. Children must not be allowed to play on the equipment, in the toilets or outside;
- Children are not allowed to play in the school grounds unsupervised or wander around the school;
- Each team must check their training area for rubbish and drink bottles and clean up after themselves;
- The court must be left clean and tidy at the end of each night so it is ready for the school to use the next day.

Our club is very lucky to have the use of these schools and we should show our appreciation by looking after their facilities.

Please note that we have zero tolerance for abuse of our Coaches, employees and Committee who give up their time so your children can play. Breaches of the [Codes of Conduct](#) will result in removal from our programs.
